G(bar) = 355433 (ACTUAL 3RD FRET, 2ND IN RESPECT TO CAPO)

C(bar) = 336663 (ACTUAL 3RD FRET, 2ND IN RESPECT TO CAPO)

D(bar) = 557775 (ACTUAL 5TH FRET, 4TH IN RESPECT TO CAPO)

The reason for the barring at the actual fret is so that the chord will be a 1/2 step lower than the actual chord before the keychange at

So rather than playing a G then G#, i found it easier to play with Capo 1st and barring!!
